## BYLAW #3-86

## A BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MORRIS SCHOOL LOCATED ON

## THE NORTH WEST OF 8-33-26-W2 AS MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY

WHEREAS PART III OF THE HERITAGE PROPERTY ACT AUTHORIZES THE COUNCIL OF RURAL MUNICIPALITY TO ENACT BYLAWS TO DESIGNATE REAL PROPERTY, INCLUDING ALL BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES THEREON, TO BE OF ARCHITECTURAL, HISTORICAL OR NATURAL VALUE OR INTEREST; AND

WHEREAS THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VISCOUNT #341 HAS CAUSED TO BE SERVED ON THE OWNERS OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES KNOWN AS THE MORRIS SCHOOL ON THE NW-8-33-26-W2 A NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SO DESIGNATE THE AFORESAID REAL PROPERTY AND HAS CAUSED SUCH NOTICE OF INTENTION TO BE PUBLISHED IN AT LEAST TWO ISSUES OF A NEWSPAPER WITH GENERAL CIRCULATION IN THE MUNICIPALITY WITH THE FIRST PUBLICATION AT LEAST TWENTY-ONE (21) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF CONSIDERATION OF THE BYLAW AND WITH THE LAST PUBLICATION AT LEAST SEVEN (7) DAYS PRIOR TO THE DATE OF THAT CONSIDERATION: and

WHEREAS NO NOTICE OF OBJECTION TO THE PROPOSED DESIGNATION HAS BEEN SERVED ON THE ADMINISTRATIOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY:

THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VISCOUNT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THERE IS DESIGNATED AS BEING OF ARCHITECTURAL AND HISTORICAL VALUE OR INTEREST THE REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE MORRIS SCHOOL ON THE NW-8-33-26-W2 AND LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS:

ALL THAT PORTION OF THE NORTH WEST QUARTER OF SECTION EIGHT(8), IN TOWNSHIP THIRTY-THREE (33), IN RANGE TWENTY-SIX, WEST OF THE SECOND MERIDIAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, IN THE DOMINION OF CANADA, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCING AT THE NORTH EAST CORNER OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, THENCE WEST ALONG THE NORTH BOUNDARY THEREOF, THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY (330) FEET, THENCE SOUTH PARALLEL WITH THE EAST BOUNDARY OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, TWO HUNDRED AND SIXTY -FOUR (264) FEET, THENCE EAST PARALLEL WITH SAID NORTH BOUNDARY TO SAID EAST BOUNDARY, THENCE NORTH ALONG THE SAID EAST BOUNDARY TO THE POINT OF COMMENCE-MENT, MINERALS EXCEPTED AS IN TRANSFER NO. FP 4059.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE SITE IS AS FOLLOWS:

- CONSTRUCTED IN 1918, MORRIS SCHOOL IS ONE OF THE FEW REMAINING ONE ROOM Α. SCHOOLS.
- THE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN OF THE SCHOOL IS TYPICAL OF THE MANY EARLY SCHOOLS WHICH DOTTED THE PRAIRIES.
- С. MORRIS SHCOOL IS A COMMUNITY LANDMARK AND IS STILL USED FOR GATHERINGS SUCH AS SPORTSDAYS, COMMUNITY PICNICS AND BRIDAL SHOWERS.
- THE R.M. ADMINISTRATOR IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO CAUSE A COPY OF THIS BYLAW TO BE SERVED ON THE OWNERS OF THE AFORESAID PROPERTY AND ON THE MINISTER AND TO CAUSE NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF THIS BYLAW.
- THE R.M. ADMINISTRATOR IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO CAUSE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS BYLAW TO BE REGISTERED AGAINST THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED ABOVE IN THE PROPER LAND TITLES OFFICE.
- THIS BYLAW SHALL COME INTO FORCE AND TAKE EFFECT ON THE DAY OF THE FINAL PASSING THEREOF.
