


RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VISCOUNT NO. 341
BYLAW NO. 2018-02

A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES


THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VISCOUNT NO. 341, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
 - b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
 - c) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Viscount No. 341.
2. The administrator, together with another person designated by council to sign cheques on its behalf, is hereby authorized to pay certain accounts either by cheques or by electronic transfer in a timely fashion, namely:
 - a) wages and salaries payable to municipal employees;
 - b) employee payroll deductions, including municipal contributions;
 - c) telephone, heat, power, water and sewer services;
 - d) Municipal MasterCard statement; and
 - e) collections on behalf of other taxing authorities;
3. The administrator shall advise council at its next regular meeting of the particulars of transactions undertaken in accordance with section 2 of this bylaw, including but not limited to:
 - a) the transaction date
 - b) the payment number
 - c) the amount paid
 - d) the payee
4. Members of council are hereby authorized to expend for repairs in the case of an emergency to a public works an amount not exceeding \$5,000.00.
5. When a member of council authorizes an expenditure in accordance with section 4 of this bylaw, the member shall advise council at its next meeting the amount and nature of the expenditure.
6. Prior to the expenditure of any funds pursuant to section 4, the approval of the Reeve, and in his absence the Deputy Reeve, must be obtained.
7. Bylaw #2-89 is hereby repealed.
8. Bylaw #1-90 is hereby repealed.






