BYLAW NO. 2018-04


A BYLAW TO AUTHORIZE FIRE FIGHTING AND SETTING A MINIMUM FEE

THE COUNCIL OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VISCOUNT NO. 341, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Viscount in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:
 - a. "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Viscount;
 - b. "Service Provider" shall mean Viscount and District Fire Association.
2. Fire suppression and/or prevention services shall be delivered subject to the availability of fire fighting equipment on behalf of the Municipality by a Service Provider as provided in Bylaw #2018-03.
3. The Municipality shall charge the cost of the fire prevention and suppression services directly to the person(s) who receives the service.
4. The Municipality shall invoice the cost for services provided within the Village of Viscount for payment and the Village shall be responsible for billing the resident for the fee for service.
5. Fees relative to the service(s) identified in Section 2 of this bylaw shall be as follows:
 - a. Equipment Rates
 - i) \$900.00 per hour, pro-rated in 15 minute increments after the first hour.
 - b. Firefighter Rate
 - i) \$20.00 per fireman, per hour
6. The minimum cost of a fire fighting service call shall be \$913.00 plus the cost of supplies used.
7. If all or a portion of the charge noted in Section 3 of this bylaw remain unpaid after 90 days, the Municipality may add the amount owing to the taxes on any parcel of land owned by the person.
8. Bylaw 04-06 is hereby repealed.
